For a time, the Hubble telescope was the **brunt** of jokes and subject to the wrath of those who believed 1. the U.S. government had spent too much money on space projects that served no valid purpose. The distant galaxies are speeding away from Earth, some traveling at the 11. speed of light. 12. Hubble has viewed exploding stars such as the Eta Carinae, which clearly displayed clouds of gas and dust 13. billowing outward from its poles at 1.5 million miles an hour.
