Certainly no creature in the sea is odder than the common sea cucumber. Usually the creatures are cucumber-shaped-hence their name -and because they are typically rock inhabitants, this shape, combine with flexibility, enables them to squeeze into crevices where they are safe from predators and ocean currents. 13. Although they have voracious appetites, eating day and night, sea cucumbers have the capacity to 14. become quiescent and live at a low metabolic rate-feeding sparingly or not at all for long periods, so that the 15. marine organisms that provide their food have a chance to multiply. If it were not for this faculty, they would devour all the food available in a short time and would probably starve themselves out of existence.
